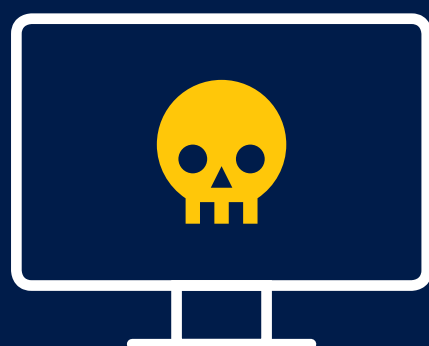


The State of Cyberthreats in the Retail Industry

The Ponemon Institute found that cyberattacks on retailers are becoming more frequent, targeted, and complex while the retail industry is struggling to defend itself.

The 3 most common reported attack methods on retailers are

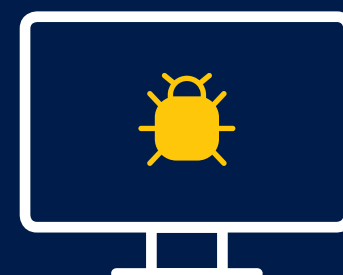
